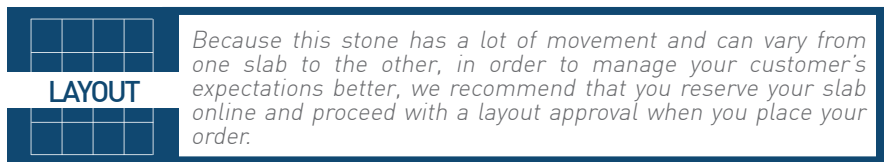


# TITANIUM




## Description

Titanium is a stone with grey, golden, black, cream and ivory veining extracted from Brazil. This region offers not only a fascinating culture, but its geodiversity, volcanoes and numerous famous rivers have resulted in the creation of a stone such as Titanium, that brings an eye-catching effect worthy of a masterpiece to homes of those lucky enough to incorporate a parcel of this Brazilian jewel to their decor.

Titanium has a unique composition of mica, quartzite and biotite. Because this stone includes areas with higher levels of quartz, harder than other minerals, and areas that have softer minerals, it is normal that the edge shows a certain waving effect after fabrication. A beveled or eased edge will minimize this effect. The softer areas in the stone are more prone to scratching.
