AVALANCHE

Description

Avalanche is extracted from a quarry in Brazil. This stone originates from the same quarry as Nobilis, except that it is a traditional transversal cut whereas Nobilis is vein cut. Of the dolomite family (which contain more magnesium), this stone offers a greater resistance to scratching and acids than other marbles.

This marble is an excellent alternative to the Calacatta stone most commonly used on kitchen countertops. Avalanche is a white marble that creates a dynamic and dramatic effect. Whites and greys swirl together, rendering a beautiful finish to islands, counters and a variety of interior applications. The honed finish will have the advantage of camouflaging marks, whereas the polished finish will reflect light exquisitely. Fiberglass is applied to the back of the stone to ensure safe manipulation and fabrication. As any natural stone, the application of a sealer is recommended to extend its beauty through time.
