SOAPSTONE SMOKE

Description

Soapstone Smoke is extracted in Brazil. Traditionally, soapstone has been used in Brazil as a cooking surface because of its capacity to retain heat during several hours. Steatite is ideal for countertops and fireplace contours. Hot objects can be set directly onto a steatite counter without fear of damaging its surface. Because this stone includes a considerable amount of talc, acids from foods will not create etching or discolouration. Soapstone Smoke is prone to scratching, therefore we recommend the use of cutting boards. Because it is extremely dense, steatite is nonporous, naturally antibacterial and stain resistant. Soapstone Smoke has a factory-applied wax on the slab to bring out the richness of its colouration. Fibreglass is glued to the back of the stone to ensure safe manipulation and fabrication. Soapstone should be oiled every 4 to 6 months depending on the level of usage.
