Description

Antique Brown is extracted from a quarry in the Huila region in Angola, a land rich of a vast mineral reserve that enables them to export various magnificent colors. The stone is then transformed in Spain or Italy. Very few quarries distribute all the way to North America. The Antique Brown is an opportunity to bring a parcel of the beauty, culture and warmth that this region of the world has to offer, and incorporate it into the comfort of our homes. Its dark greyish-browns and crystal-white spots bring out the subtle variations of the stone. The slab is comprised of dark-brown irregular crystals with metallic glints of mica, tribute to Angola's beautiful precipitous landscapes. Often, its crystals will show white striations that are apparent on large slab areas. Also, very fine veinage can have the appearance of cracks, but it is actually the stone's natural color.
