

FERRATO

Description

Ferrato is a granite from Brazil, one of the largest exporters of natural stone in the world. Its warm color is the product of a high-quality stain applied in the controlled environment on the stone New Azul Aran; a process that respects the strictest industry standards while honoring its country of origin. Thanks to its geodiversity, its volcanoes and various famous wild rivers, Brazil can fulfill the needs of the finest connoisseurs and create a stone such as Ferrato that offers depth characterized by the ochre and brown hues that will have those who incorporate a parcel of this Brazilian jewel to their decor dreaming of this exotic place.

In the course of the polishing process, an epoxy resin is applied to the stone's surface to fill part of its porosity (or pores) and natural cracks that may be apparent. This has no incident on the durability, the maintenance or the beauty of the natural stone. It is possible that certain pores are too small to contain efficiently the resin, and reopen during the finishing stages. However, this does not affect the stone's quality or beauty. Such as it is the case with many natural stones, it is recommended to apply a sealer to extend its beauty through time.





Because this stone has a lot of movement and can vary from one slab to the other, in order to manage your customer's expectations better, we recommend that you reserve your slab online and proceed with a layout approval when you place your order.
