Description

Bianco Carrara is extracted from an underground quarry in Carrara, situated in the Tuscan mountainous region in Italy. This colorful baroque-style city is considered the birthplace of luxury bathrooms. The Pantheon, the Trajan column and several famous sculptures from the Renaissance era, such as The David from Michelangelo, have all been created from marbles of Carrara.

Bianco Carrara is one of many white marbles produced in this area. This emblematic stone contains grey veining. However, during winter, most quarries are closed due to snow. Bianco Carrara has the best return on investment of all white marbles from this region. Pores are a standard occurrence in Bianco Carrara, as it is the case for many white marbles produced in the area. It is also a softer stone, that is more subject to scratching and abrasion. As it is the case with many natural stones, a sealer is recommended to extend its beauty through time.
